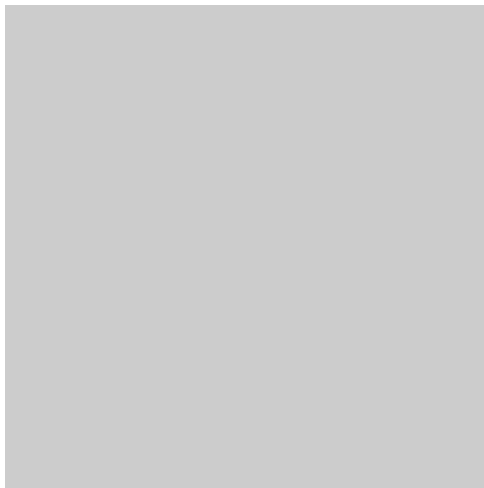
Southgate Library Art Show



Congratulations to Mrs. Melissa's class who won a special award for their exploration of primary and secondary colors!
